

Notice to members of Updating AIH Rules 2023.

AIH last updated its Rules (constitution) n 2006.

The ACT Associations Incorporated Act provides the option to use the model rules as set out in the Act's regulations. The AIH team have reviewed the template for the model rules as provided and as recommended by the ACT Registrar General.

The AIH team have worked together and found that the ACT Act model rules meet our needs. The benefit being that the AIH will not need to submit updated rules with each review of the Act unless AIH has found that the rules do not our meet our constitutional needs.

This approach also allows AIH to develop standard operating procedures providing the flexibility to update our procedures as management needs arise.

The AIH team have reviewed our current by-laws in place since 2006. The team considered the need to meet changes in reporting requirements, implementation of new technology, support and service mechanisms and providing procedures for the effective management of AIH. The result is an expanded document that will assist current and future office holders of AIH to manage AIH and set clear guidelines to our service providers.

After consideration by the AIH Committee the team presents the members with the new AIH Rules to replace our current constitution and an expanded Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) – these replacing our current By-laws.

The AIH Committee have directed the team to present the draft documents to our members for their consideration.

The vote for the new Rules and SOPS will be held during the AGM to be held 5:30pm October 26th 2023 at the **Cairns Botanical Gardens Visitor Centre**, **64 Collins Avenue**, **Edgehill** during which time members will be asked to vote on acceptance of the new AIH rules and SOPS.
